Presentations: Please prepare short flash talks of 15 minutes. For each talk, we have scheduled an extra 5 minutes for clarification questions and transition from one speaker to the next. In your talk, focus on giving everyone an idea of what you are currently working on and what you are grappling with. Your talk should provide a good foundation for going into more detail during the academic hike, during which you will have the opportunity to discuss specific questions, ask for feedback, etc.

Hiking: This will be a rather leisurely walk, but we will cover some distance, so be sure to bring appropriate footwear, water and maybe a snack if your blood sugar drops as quickly as mine. As long as there is only a light drizzle, we will walk regardless – in which case a rain coat might come in handy, too. If it rains badly, we have prepared an indoors alternative.

Corona policy: Given that we are max. 10 people, current Corona measures by the state Niedersachsen and the Leuphana regulations allow us to hold the first part of the workshop in person in one large seminar room. In case something changes, we have booked back-up rooms that allow us to assign participants to individual rooms and hold the first part of the workshop via Zoom. (Please bring your laptops so that you can “Zoom in” if necessary.)

Please take note of Leuphana’s Corona rules:

- All participants should be either vaccinated, recovered or tested (“Rapid tests” a.k.a. “Schnelltests” should be no older than 24 hours, PCR tests no older than 48 hours – ideally still valid when we go to dinner!).
- Individuals with Corona symptoms are not allowed on campus.
- Quarantine / entry rules must be followed if you have recently been traveling.
- Rooms must be ventilated regularly.
- Inside: 1.5m distance must be maintained.
- Inside: if distances cannot be maintained, masks must be worn.
- Masks must be worn in front of entrances, in buildings (outside the seminar rooms) and in parking lots.

There is a testing facility on campus which performs rapid tests between 8am and 2pm, details: <https://www.leuphana.de/en/portals/coronavirus/news/single-view/2021/05/06/update-information-for-employees-about-the-corona-test-station-on-campus.html>. We will verify that you can use this service even if you are only a guest and not an employee of Leuphana. I will send an update if this is not the case.

Travelling from Hamburg: RE3 82115 (towards Uelzen) leaves at 8:57 am from Hamburg Hauptbahnhof. From Lüneburg Hauptbahnhof you can take the bus or a DB Bike to campus. You will arrive on Campus by 10:00 am latest.

Online participants: A few additional people asked if it was possible to participate online. Since we will most likely be able to hold both parts of the workshop in person, this might be slightly complicated. We will, however, open a Zoom room on the presenter laptop for the first part of the workshop (10:15-13:00), and ask each presenter to share their slides in the room while presenting. While we hope that this should allow people to participate at least passively for the talks, we cannot guarantee that the audio quality will actually be good enough to make this worth your while. But feel free to tune in and check for yourself.
